Re: Guess?, Inc.—COVID-19 Temporary Furloughs

Dear Sir/Madam,

Because of the effects on business of emergency efforts being imposed to slow down the COVID-19 outbreak, Guess?, Inc. must place employees working at the locations listed on the attached address list ("the Guess? Facilities") on temporary furlough. Because of these unforeseen circumstances, designated employees working at the Guess? Facilities will be placed temporarily on unpaid leave status from their jobs. The accompanying address list indicates that a complete temporary closure will take place at each of the facilities.

Furloughs will begin on April 2, 2020 or during a 14-day period starting on that date. Unfortunately, because of the sudden, dramatic, and unexpected nature of this unforeseen calamity, and the demands placed without notice on businesses and the public to cease or curtail operations to limit the spread of the COVID-19 outbreak, we are unable to provide employees with additional notice of these furloughs. Our operations were unexpectedly and rapidly affected by the COVID-19 pandemic, the World Health Organization's pandemic declaration on March 11, the President's declaration of a national emergency on March 13, local Safer-at-Home or Shelter-in-Place Orders and other related governmental announcements and actions.

No one will have the right to bump or displace other employees. There are no unions representing affected employees. A list of job titles and the number of employees currently holding affected positions, as well as any other information required pursuant to 20 C.F.R. §639.7(f), will be maintained on site and readily accessible to the state dislocated worker unit and to the units of general local government.

This announcement and the above timetable are based on the best information currently available. You will be informed of any significant changes in these plans as additional information becomes available.

This is a difficult, but necessary decision that we are making to help ensure health and safety of our staff and their families. To the extent that the temporary unpaid leave constitutes a covered event under the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act (WARN), or any similar state statute, this letter is intended to fulfill any requirements imposed under these provisions. By

providing this information, however, the Company does not concede that any such provision applies or that notice is required.
