Dear Gentilepersons:

This letter is to inform you Sommerpointe Realty, LLC (the “Company”) intends to temporarily suspend its entire operations at the Tahiti Resort and the Club de Soleil Resort (referred to collectively as the “Resorts”), which are located at 5101 West Tropicana Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada 89103 and 5499/5625 West Tropicana Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada 89103, respectively.

A total of 5 employees employed by the Company at the Resorts will be temporarily laid off from their employment due to this suspension of operations. We expect the first separation from employment to take place April 2, 2020. These layoffs will continue indefinitely but are intended to be temporary and last less than six months. Please be advised bumping rights do not exist.

We are taking this action because of business circumstances related to COVID-19 that were not reasonably foreseeable. While we would have liked to have provided you more notice of this action, we were unable to do so because of how quickly our operations were affected by the COVID-19 pandemic, the World Health Organization’s March 11, 2020 pandemic declaration, the March 13, 2020 Declaration of a National Emergency by the President of the United States, and the COVID-19 related Emergency Declarations and Directives issued by the Governor of Nevada.
