Please accept this letter as notification pursuant to the Worker Adjustment Retraining and Notification Act (WARN), 29 U.S.C. § 2101 on behalf of Flamingo Paradise Gaming, LLC, The Primadonna Company, LLC, and Plantation Investments, LLC that the Silver Sevens Hotel & Casino, located at 4100 Paradise Road, Las Vegas, NV 89169, Whiskey Pete's Hotel & Casino, located at 100 W Primm Blvd, Primm, NV 89019, Primm Valley Resort & Casino, located at 31900 S. Las Vegas Blvd, Primm, NV 89019, Buffalo Bill's Hotel & Casino, located at 31700 S. Las Vegas Blvd, Primm, NV 89019, and Rail City Casino, located at 2121 Victorian Ave, Sparks, NV 89431, have implemented temporary furloughs. These furloughs will occur on April 17, 2020. This action will affect 1,093 employees.

As you know, the COVID-19 virus has reached pandemic proportions and the federal government and many states have declared a state of emergency. Further, casinos in the state have been ordered to close. These sudden and unexpected circumstances adversely affected our business operations and, unfortunately, prevented us from providing notice sooner.
