## Mr. Reed:

Please accept this letter as notification pursuant to the Worker Adjustment Retraining and Notification Act (WARN), 29 U.S.C. § 2101 on behalf of Affinity Gaming, located at 3755 Breakthrough Way, #300, Las Vegas, NV 89135, has implemented temporary furloughs. These furloughs will occur on April 17, 2020. This action will affect 21 employees.

As you know, the COVID-19 virus has reached pandemic proportions and the federal government and many states have declared a state of emergency. Further, casinos in the state have been ordered to close. These sudden and unexpected circumstances adversely affected our business operations and, unfortunately, prevented us from providing notice sooner.
