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February Unemployment Rate Below National Average in all but One of Nevada's Counties

According to the Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation's ([DETR](#)) February 2021 economic report, Nevada's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 8.3 percent in February 2021, higher than the 3.7 percent that Nevada had in February 2020. Seasonally adjusted estimates account for regularly seen economic patterns; the rest of the estimates in this release have not been seasonally adjusted.

In the three Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSA), the unemployment rates were 9.3 percent in the Las Vegas area, 4.9 percent in Reno, and the Carson area has an unemployment rate of 5.4 percent in February 2021.

In Nevada's counties the lowest unemployment rate was in Eureka County at 2.7 percent, while Clark County had the highest rate at 9.3 percent. Since December 2020 Humboldt County remained unchanged, five counties increased by 0.1 percentage points, and the remaining eleven counties decreased. Compared to the national unadjusted rate of 6.6 percent, only Clark County had an unemployment rate higher than the national average. February's unemployment generally improved when compared to January 2021, but is still up from February 2020. The state has an unemployment rate of 8.3 percent, when accounting for seasonal patterns, which is higher than the national rate of 6.2 percent. Within the state, rates ranged from 2.7 percent in Eureka County to 9.3 percent in Clark County. Only Clark County had a higher unemployment rate than the unadjusted national average of 6.6 percent in February. Within Clark County the city of North Las Vegas has the highest unemployment rate in the state at 10.4 percent.

When looking at unemployment claims in February there were slight increases in many of the state's counties. In February, there were 33,878 initial claims in Nevada an increase of 24,063 claims from February 2020, but down from a high of 208,869 claims in March 2020. Most claims were in the Clark County area.

Figures for our unemployment estimates come from the Local Area Unemployment Statistics (LAUS) program, a state/federal partnership sponsored by the Bureau of Labor Statistics ([BLS-LAUS](#)). This program produces monthly and annual employment, unemployment, and labor force data for census regions, states, counties, metropolitan areas, and many large cities, based on place of residence. 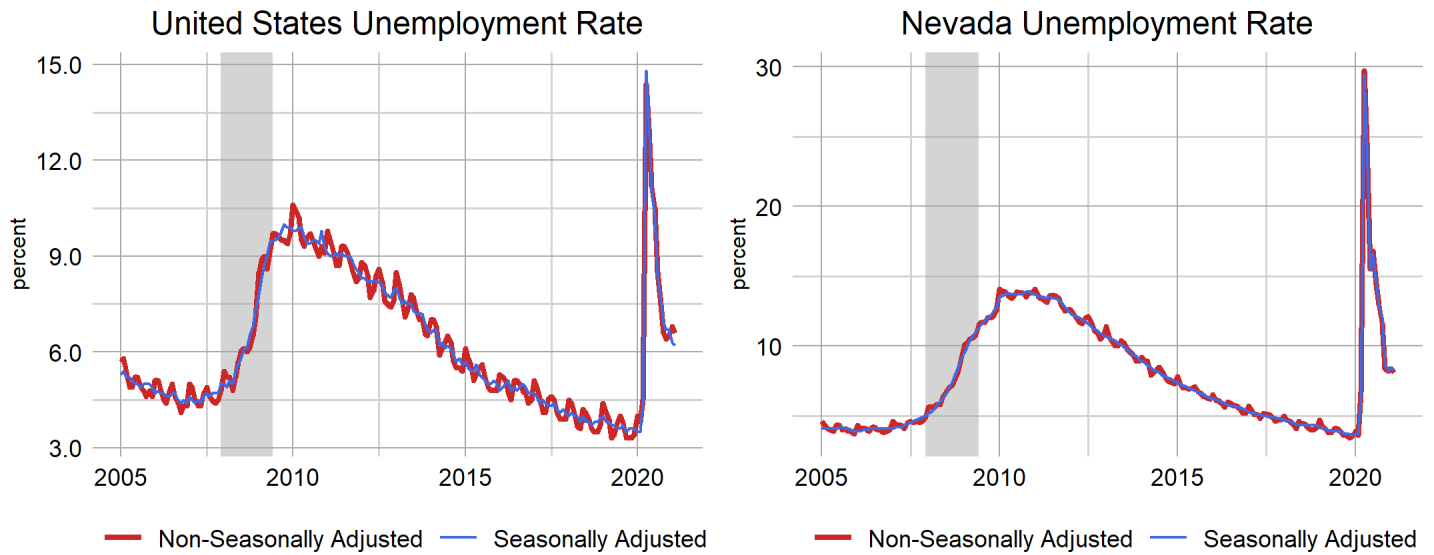

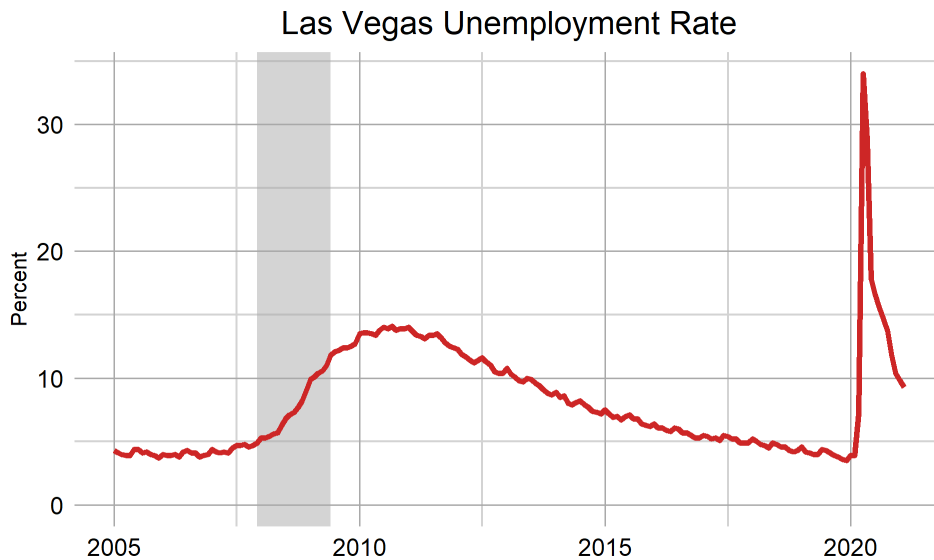

Seasonally adjusted estimates account for regularly seen seasonal employment patterns such as holiday hiring, beach season, ski season, or other jobs with seasonal components. The result of a seasonally adjusted estimate is usually a smoother estimate from which underlying economic trends can be seen. Adjusted estimates are in the summary table above, and in many of the other tables and figures through this document.

Nevada’s unemployment rate was 8.3 percent in February 2021, decreasing from 8.5 percent in January 2021, and up from 3.7 percent in February 2020, seasonally adjusted. The number of unemployed individuals decreased by 1,976 since January 2021 for a current level of 128,587 people, which is 68,792 more unemployed people than February 2020. The labor force in Nevada is currently 1,545,250 people, which is 9,204 more people than January 2021, and is down 54,201 people since February 2020.



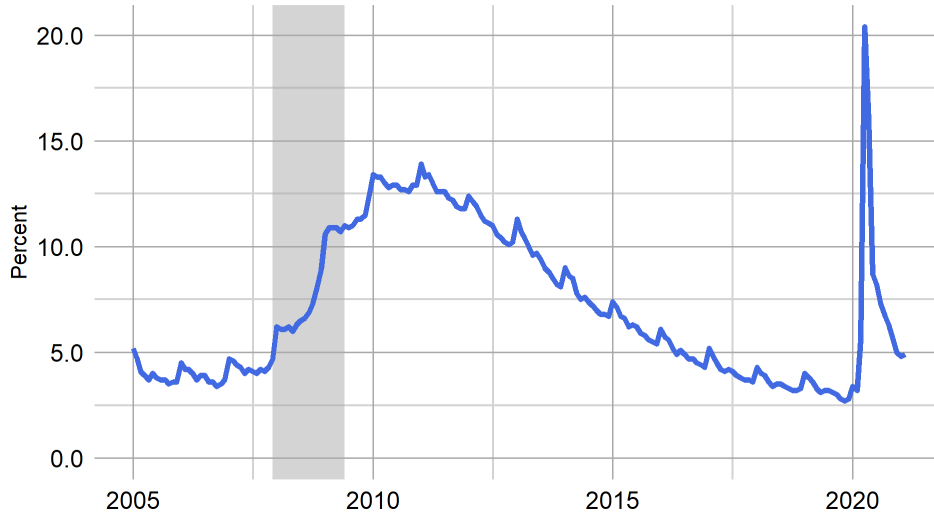
The Las Vegas MSA’s unemployment rate was 9.3 percent in February 2021, decreasing from 9.8 percent in January 2021, and up from 3.9 percent in February 2020, non-seasonally adjusted. The number of unemployed individuals decreased by 3,916 since January 2021 for a current level of 104,268 people, which is 59,514 more unemployed people than February 2020. The labor force in Las Vegas is currently 1,120,978 people, which is 14,227 more people than January 2021, and is down 33,154 people since February 2020.

The Reno MSA's unemployment rate was 4.9 percent in February 2021, increasing from 4.8 percent in January 2021, and up from 3.2 percent in February 2020, non-seasonally adjusted. The number of unemployed individuals increased by 483 since January 2021 for a current level of 13,318 people, which is 4,802 more unemployed people than February 2020. The labor force in Reno is currently 272,953 people, which is 5,895 more people than January 2021, and is up 9,119 people since February 2020.

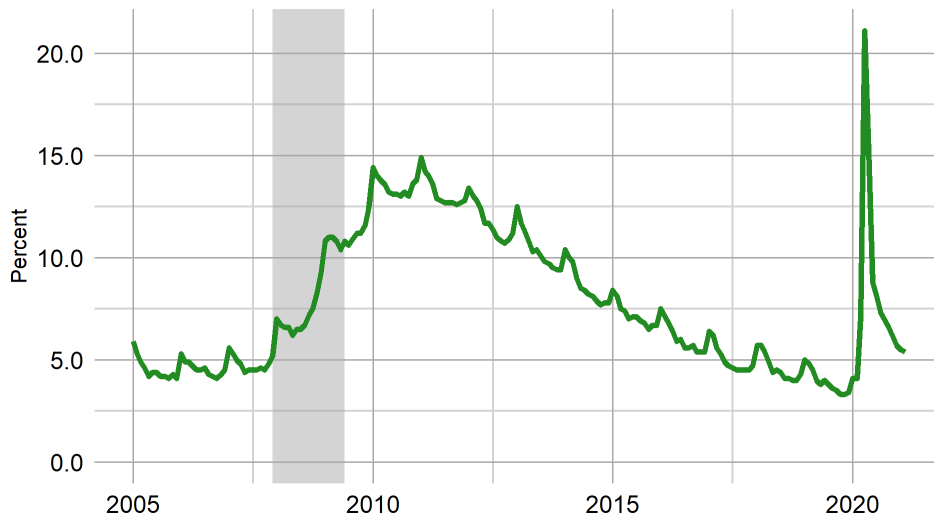
Reno Unemployment Rate

The Carson City MSA's unemployment rate was 5.4 percent in February 2021, decreasing from 5.5 percent in January 2021, and up from 4.1 percent in February 2020, non-seasonally adjusted. The number of unemployed individuals increased by 23 since January 2021 for a current level of 1,503 people, which is 397 more unemployed people than February 2020. The labor force in Carson City is currently 27,620 people, which is 838 more people than January 2021, and is up 731 people since February 2020.

Unemployment Insurance Benefits (UI)

Initial claims for unemployment insurance totaled 33,878 statewide in February 2021, down 21.3 percent from January's total. While considerable, this decline follows Nevada's typical seasonal trend seen in non-pandemic years. At the county level, the decline statewide was primarily driven by large decreases in Clark County. The counties in the remainder of the state saw little change in the level of initial claims. Continued claims for the regular unemployment insurance, which are a proxy for the number of persons filing for regular benefits in a given week, also saw declines in Clark County but little change across the rest of the state. Continued claims levels have been more stable in the recent months as most of Nevada's claimants are receiving benefits from the pandemic extension programs.

Looking to other measures of unemployment insurance activity, we saw similar trends in the number of first payments as with initial claims. In Clark County, we saw large declines in the number of first payments as compared to January which drove the statewide down. The rest of the state actually saw some increases in the number of first payments. Claim exhaustions continue to decline across all counties as most of Nevada's claimants have already exhausted their regular program benefit weeks and are likely receiving pandemic extension program benefits.

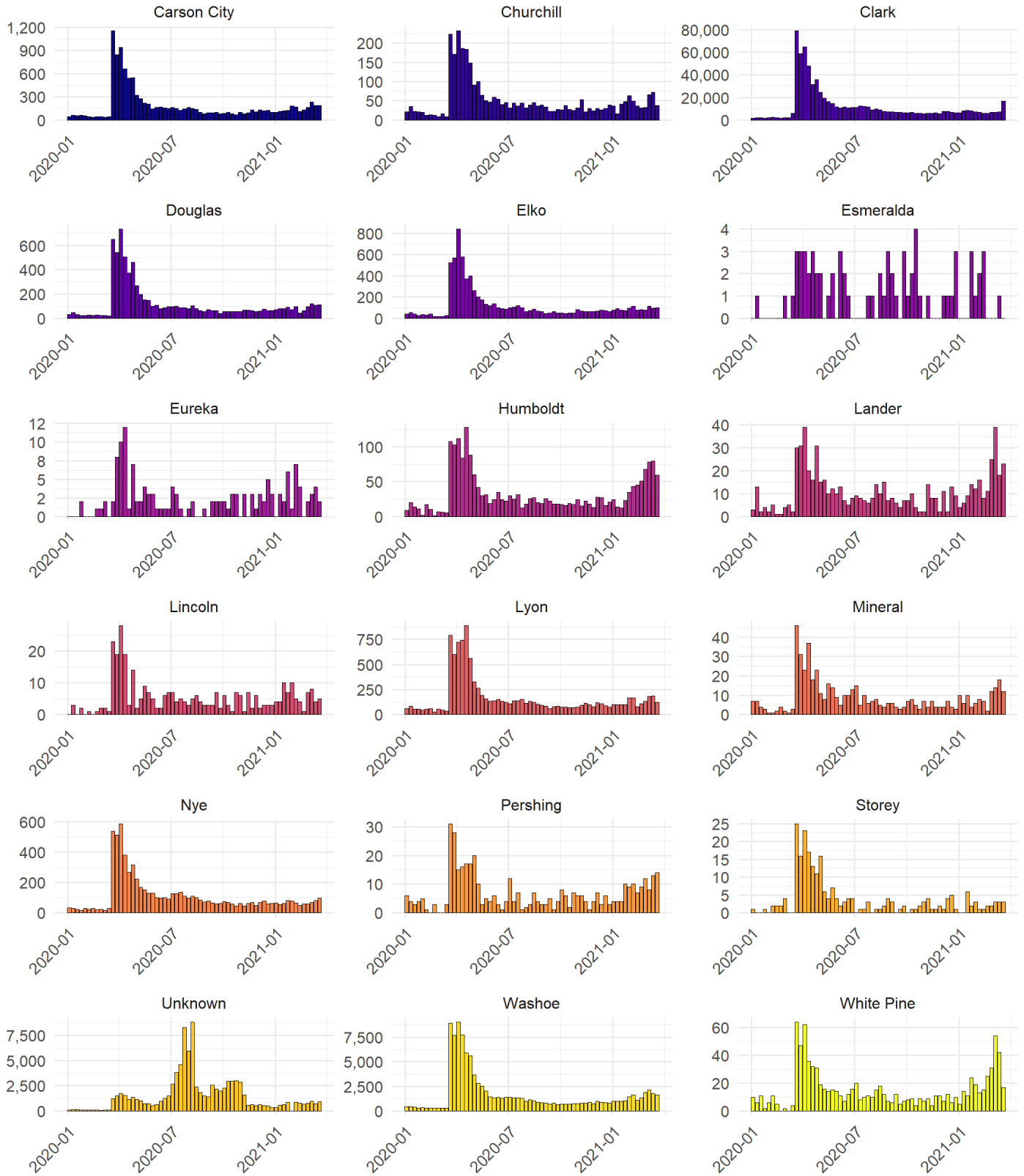

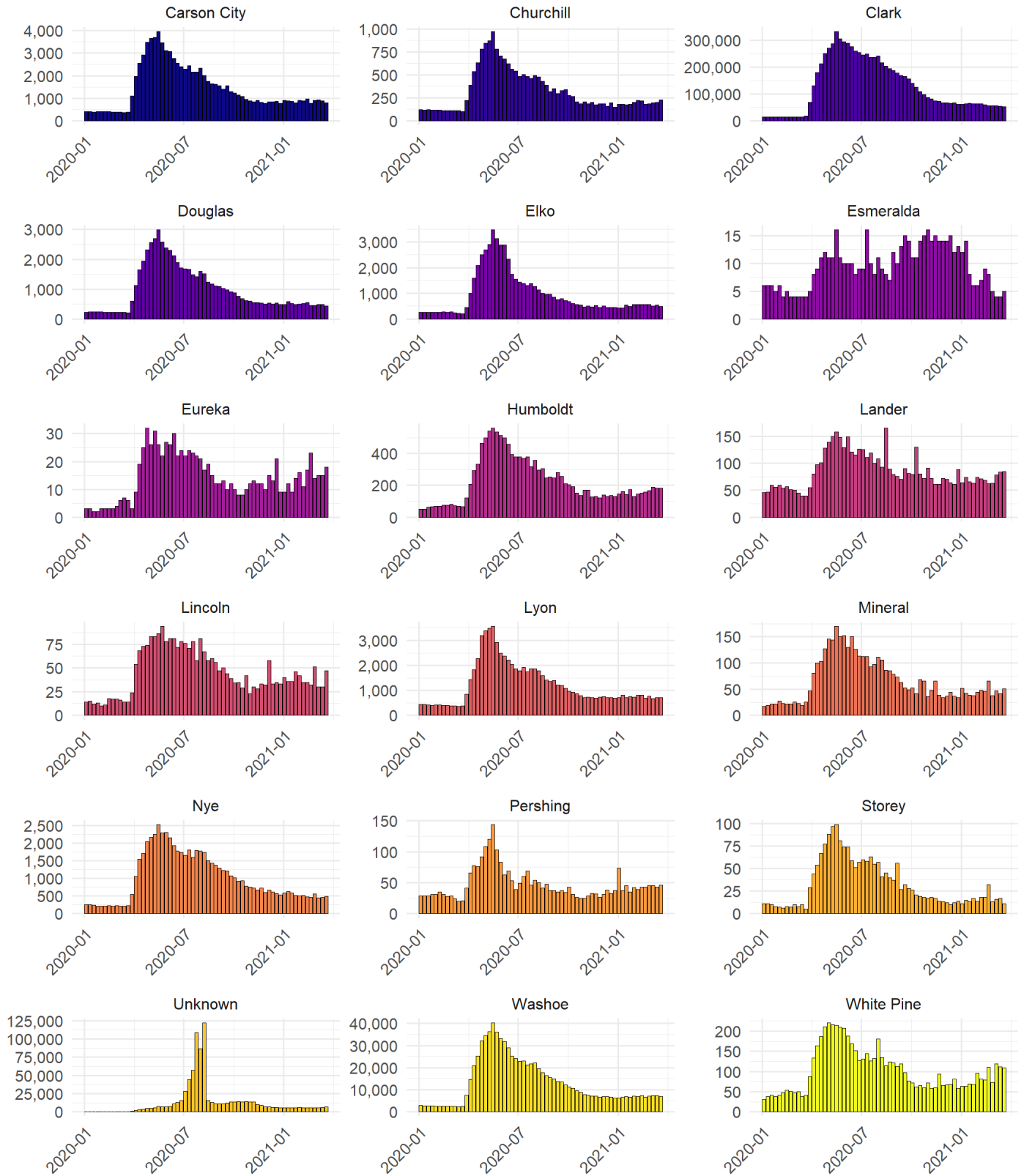
Initial Claims by County
