

# Nevada Employment Security Division Recommended Identification Documents

## A.

- A U.S. passport
- > A certificate of U.S. citizenship
- A naturalization certificate
- An unexpired foreign passport if the passport has an unexpired endorsement by the Attorney General for work in the U.S., or
- A resident alien card or registration card if it contains a photograph and is evidence of authorization for employment
- Temporary Resident Card, INS Form I-688
- Employment Authorization Card, INS Form I-688A

In the event the candidate cannot present one document satisfying both requirements, other documents -- one each from categories 2 & 3 -- must be examined.

### B.

- Social Security card (unless it states on its face that it does not authorize employment)
- U.S. Birth Certificate
- Any other document approved by Attorney General
- An unexpired reentry permit INS Form I-327
- An unexpired Refugee Travel document INS Form I-571
- A certification of birth issued by the Department of State, Form FS-545
- An employment authorization document issued by INS
- Native American tribal document
- U.S. citizen I.D. card INS Form I-197
- I.D. card for use of resident citizen in the United States INS Form I- 179

# C. Identification

- Driver's license or state I.D. card if it contains a photograph or other sufficient identifying information
- Other identification approved by the Attorney General
- School identification card with a photograph
- Voter registration card
- U.S. Military card
- I.D. card issued by federal, state, or local government agencies or entities Military dependent's I.D. card
- Native American tribal document
- U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner card
- Canadian driver's license
