Unemployment holds steady statewide: Metro areas remain below 10 percent

According to the Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation's ([DETR](#)) June 2021 economic report, Nevada's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 7.8 percent in June 2021 unchanged from May 2021. Seasonally adjusted estimates account for regularly seen economic patterns; the following sub-state area estimates are not seasonally adjusted.

In the three Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSA), the unemployment rates were 9.6 percent in the Las Vegas area, 4.9 percent in Reno, and 5.3 percent in the Carson area in June 2021.

In Nevada's counties the lowest unemployment rate was in Eureka County at 2.5 percent, and Clark County had the highest rate at 9.6 percent. For a look at unemployment rates in your county visit our [Area Profiles Page](#).

Initial claims declined in most counties in June. On average, counties saw a 2 percent decrease in initial claims while continued claims stayed relatively unchanged.

The state had an unemployment rate of 7.8 percent in June 2021, unchanged from the previous month and down from 15.4 percent in June of 2020. Within the state, rates ranged from 2.5 percent in Eureka County to 9.6 percent in Clark County. Within Clark County, the city of North Las Vegas had the highest unemployment rate in the state at 11 percent.

Initial claims continued their downward trend in June with claims declining by 33 percent since May. In June there were 10,248 initial claims in Nevada. Claims in the state peaked at 208,869 initial claims in the month of March 2020.

Figures for our unemployment estimates come from the Local Area Unemployment Statistics (LAUS) program, a state/federal partnership sponsored by the Bureau of Labor Statistics ([BLS-LAUS](#)). This program produces monthly and annual employment, unemployment, and labor force data for census regions, states, counties, metropolitan areas, and many large cities, based on place of residence. 



Seasonally adjusted estimates account for regularly seen seasonal employment patterns such as jobs associated with holiday hiring, holiday and weather seasons, or other jobs with seasonal components. The result of a seasonally adjusted estimate is usually a smoother estimate from which underlying economic trends can be seen. Adjusted estimates are in the summary table above, and in many of the other tables and figures through this document.

Nevada’s unemployment rate was 7.8 percent in June 2021, unchanged from 7.8 percent in May 2021, and down from 15.4 percent in June 2020, seasonally adjusted. The number of unemployed individuals decreased by 511 since May 2021 for a current level of 122,104 people, which is 109,957 less unemployed people than June 2020. The labor force in Nevada is currently 1,569,467 people, which is 4,836 more people than May 2021, and is up 65,119 people since June 2020.



The Las Vegas MSA’s unemployment rate was 9.6 percent in June 2021, increasing from 8.9 percent in May 2021, and down from 18.2 percent in June 2020, non-seasonally adjusted. The number of unemployed individuals increased by 7,559 since May 2021 for a current level of 108,879 people, which is 90,925 less unemployed people than June 2020. The labor force in Las Vegas is currently 1,135,718 people, which is 134 less people than May 2021, and is up 38,060 people since June 2020.



The Reno MSA’s unemployment rate was 4.9 percent in June 2021, increasing from 4.6 percent in May 2021, and down from 8.6 percent in June 2020, non-seasonally adjusted. The number of unemployed individuals increased by 706 since May 2021 for a current level of 12,990 people, which is 8,705 less unemployed people than June 2020. The labor force in Reno is currently 267,301 people, which is 1,927 less people than May 2021, and is up 14,928 people since June 2020.

The Carson City MSA’s unemployment rate was 5.3 percent in June 2021, increasing from 5 percent in May 2021, and down from 8.4 percent in June 2020, non-seasonally adjusted. The number of unemployed individuals increased by 68 since May 2021 for a current level of 1,427 people, which is 779 less unemployed people than June 2020. The labor force in Carson City is currently 26,923 people, which is 148 less people than May 2021, and is up 766 people since June 2020.

Unemployment Insurance Benefits (UI)

Initial claims for unemployment insurance totaled 10,248 statewide in June, down 33.5 percent from May. June showed the lowest total initial claims filed in 2021. The decrease in claims this month follows a similar trend from June 2020 and can be expected to continue to decline. New Covid-19 health regulations and protocols may explain the decrease in this month's initial claim total as well. Pandemic-related effects on unemployment will continue to vary these values.

Initial claims continued to decrease this month with most counties seeing a decline. On average, counties saw a 2 percent decrease in initial claims while continued claims stayed relatively unchanged. The statewide decrease in initial claims can be attributed to the decreases seen in Clark, Nye and Storey counties. Continued claims for the regular unemployment insurance, which are a proxy for the number of persons filing for regular benefits in a given week, were largely unchanged in the month. Continued claims levels have been more stable in the recent months as most of Nevada's claimants are receiving benefits from the pandemic extension programs.

Looking to other measures of unemployment insurance activity, we saw most counties' final payments decrease since last month apart from Elko, Lincoln, and Pershing county. First payments decreased in all counties with the exception of Eureka, Lincoln, and White Pine counties. Additionally, almost all counties saw a decrease in benefit payments with Mineral county seeing the largest percent decrease over the month of 42.4 percent. It should be noted that most of Nevada's claimants have already exhausted their regular program benefit weeks and are likely receiving pandemic extension program benefits.




Initial Claims by County
