




Jobs Lost and Gained, State of Nevada Jobs Lost Feb 2020 to May 2020, Gained May 2020 to September 2021




Change in Employment, September 2020 to September 2021




Nevada's Unemployment Rate Since 1976 Grey area shows high/low range for all other states




Unemployment Rate by County




Unemployment Rate Ranking August 2021 (seasonally adjusted)



Modified Unemployment Rate Ranking August 2021 (unadjusted)




Range of Unemployment Rates by Income, Disability Status, and Education Large Counties are Clark, Washoe, Carson City, Lyon and Elko Counties



Agriculture, Mining, Utilities and Construction Industries Red shows 2019 to 2020 change; blue shows projected 2020 to 2022 change




Manufacturing Industries

Red shows 2019 to 2020 change; blue shows projected 2020 to 2022 change




Trade, Transportation and Warehousing Industries Red shows 2019 to 2020 change; blue shows projected 2020 to 2022 change




Professional Services Industries

Red shows 2019 to 2020 change; blue shows projected 2020 to 2022 change




Social Services Industries

Red shows 2019 to 2020 change; blue shows projected 2020 to 2022 change




Personal Services Industries Red shows 2019 to 2020 change; blue shows projected 2020 to 2022 change




Casino Hotel Employment Compared to Series Peak

Trends and Considerations

- "Where are all the jobs?"
- Recent end of federal extended unemployment benefits. States that ended benefits early have not seen significant or rapid rebound in employment, with local economic activity more dominant.
- Ongoing waves of COVID have the potential to draw out full recovery in the state.
- Employers are reporting record levels of job openings nationwide, which should increase opportunities for employment.
- · Local experience is very different around the state, with urban Las Vegas particularly hard-hit in current data.
