Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC)

NEW - Updated American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021

The Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC) is a federal program that is part of the CARES Act. The program provides 100% federally funded benefits to eligible Unemployment Insurance (UI) claimants who have exhausted their traditional UI claim. An extension was authorized under the Continued Assistance Act (CAA) of 2021 to provide benefits from week ending January 2, 2021 through week ending March 13, 2021. ARPA extends the PEUC program to week ending September 4, 2021.

PEUC ELIGIBILITY REMINDER:

1. PEUC Eligibility: Although not all unemployment insurance (UI) claimants will be eligible for PEUC, claimants may be eligible if:
 - a. Must have exhausted all regular state UI benefits (26 weeks) on or after July 1, 2019);
 - b. Claimant’s UI benefit year ended on or after July 1, 2019 (provided a new UI benefit year eligibility cannot be established);
 - c. Must be able and available to seek or accept work once “Stay at Home” restrictions have been lifted due the COVID- 19 provisions; and
 - d. Not be eligible for traditional unemployment benefits.

PEUC BENEFIT PAYMENTS REMINDER:

- PEUC is an extension of a regular UI claim. If eligible to file PEUC, claimants receive the same weekly benefit amount as on their regular UI claim until week ending September 4, 2021.
- In addition to the weekly benefit amount, claimants will also receive the FPUC weekly \$300 payment also extended by ARPA for weeks ending March 20, 2021 through week ending September 4, 2021.

Notification will be mailed to claimants advising of potential eligibility for PEUC benefits. Claimants will need to login to their unemployment account at ui.nv.gov. The PEUC filing process steps will differ depending of the status of the person’s regular UI claim.
