Las Vegas and Reno experience modest employment gains; Carson City slight decline

CARSON CITY - According to the Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation's (DETR) October 2020 economic report, the Silver State added back 3,600 jobs (0.3%) since September 2020. When compared to October 2019, jobs are still down by 117,200 (-8.2%) for a current total of 1,305,300 jobs. Nevada's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 12 percent in October 2020 compared to 3.7 percent in October 2019. Area total estimates are seasonally adjusted to account for regularly seen economic trends, but estimates discussing sector employment and sub-state unemployment rates are not adjusted for seasonality.

The Las Vegas Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) increased by 8,100 jobs (0.9%) since September 2020 with the leisure and hospitality sector growing the most by 6,300 jobs (2.8%). Compared to October 2019, total employment saw a decrease of 111,600 jobs (-10.7%) with leisure and hospitality sector down the most by 60,200 jobs (-20.5%) despite the over the month gains. The unemployment rate for the area was 13.8 percent and is still the highest in the state.

The Reno MSA had an increase of 200 jobs (0.1%) since September 2020 with the professional and business services sector growing the most by 1,400 jobs (4.5%). Compared to October 2019, total employment saw a decrease of 15,000 jobs (-6.0%) with leisure and hospitality sector down the most by 6,200 jobs (-15.9%). The unemployment rate in Reno is 6.3 percent compared to 2.8 percent last year.

The Carson City MSA experienced a decrease of 300 jobs (-1.0%) since September 2020 with the trade, transportation, and utilities sector growing the most by 100 jobs (2.5%). Compared to October 2019, total employment saw a decrease of 1,200 jobs (-3.9%) with professional and business services sector down the most by 200 jobs (-9.1%). The Carson MSA has an unemployment rate of 6.6 percent in October 2020.

"As has been the case for the duration of the COVID recession, the Las Vegas area continues to see the most significant impacts in terms of both employment and unemployment. Statewide, employment was mixed with the Las Vegas MSA up, the Reno MSA flat, and the Carson City MSA down over the month. Nevada, at 12 percent, has the second highest unemployment rate in the nation behind Hawaii. The rate of unemployment in the Las Vegas MSA, 13.8 percent, is more than double that in Reno and Carson City, 6.3 and 6.6 percent, respectively. Although the labor market continues to improve, Nevada remains one of the states most impacted by the COVID pandemic. Our economic outlook depends on our response to COVID-19 including treatments, policy responses, and public compliance with measures to slow the spread of the disease," said David Schmidt, Chief Economist for DETR.

Additional Economic Report Highlights:

Employment (Seasonally Adjusted):

- Las Vegas employment increased by 8,100 jobs (0.9%) since September 2020 and a decrease of 111,600 jobs (-10.7%) since October 2019.
- Reno employment had an increase of 200 jobs (0.1%) since September 2020 and a decrease of 15,000 jobs (-6.0%) since October 2019.
- Carson City employment had a decrease of 300 jobs (-1.0%) since September 2020 and a decrease of 1,200 jobs (-3.9%) since October 2019.

Unemployment (Not Seasonally Adjusted):

- Las Vegas MSA's unemployment was 13.8% in October 2020 compared to September 2020's rate of 14.6% and 3.8% in October 2019.
- Reno MSA's unemployment was 6.3% in October 2020 compared to September 2020's rate of 6.7% and 2.8% in October 2019.
- Carson City MSA's unemployment was 6.6% in October 2020 compared to September 2020's rate of 6.9% and 3.3% in October 2019.
- The unemployment rate in the Elko Micropolitan area was 4.2% in October 2020 compared to September 2020's rate of 4.3% and 2.5% in October 2019.
- The Fallon area's unemployment was 4.5% in October 2020 compared to September 2020's rate of 4.7% and 3% in October 2019.
- The unemployment rate in Lyon County was 7.1% in October 2020 compared to September 2020's rate of 7.3% and 4% in October 2019.
- Douglas County's unemployment rate was 6.5% in October 2020 compared to September 2020's rate of 7% and 3.3% in October 2019.
- The unemployment rate in Nye County was 9% in October 2020 compared to September 2020's rate of 9% and 4.6% in October 2019.
- The unemployment rate in the Winnemucca area was 4.3% in October 2020 compared to September 2020's rate of 4.5% and 2.6% in October 2019.

In this release, we provide updates on our primary employment, unemployment, and unemployment insurance programs. Employment was mixed this month with the Las Vegas and Reno MSAs adding jobs at modest rates while the Carson City MSA declined slightly. Leisure and hospitality remains among the hardest hit sectors, though has shown some over the month gains in October.

Unemployment rates in the state were also mixed with three counties increasing compared to September, two unchanged, and twelve showing decreases all compared to September. The highest unemployment rates are still concentrated in the Las Vegas MSA with North Las Vegas having the highest rate in the state at 14.6 percent and the MSA at 13.8 percent. Eureka County has the lowest rate in the state at 2.8 percent which is still up from this time last year at 2.0 percent, and the county's all-time low of 1.9 percent.



Las Vegas MSA seasonally adjusted total nonfarm employment realized an increase of 8,100 jobs (0.9%) from September 2020 to October 2020. Compared to October 2019 total nonfarm employment saw a decrease of 111,600 jobs (-10.7%). The mining and logging sector add back 100 jobs (20.0%) in the Las Vegas MSA and was the only supersector to show growth in October.


Reno seasonally MSA adjusted total nonfarm employment realized an increase of 200 jobs (0.1%) from September 2020 to October 2020. Compared to October 2019 total nonfarm employment saw a decrease of 15,000 jobs (-6.0%). No supersectors in the Reno MSA showed over the year growth, but three sectors did show no change in employment mining and logging (0.0%), manufacturing (0.0%), and financial activities (0.0%). Sector estimates are not adjusted for seasonality.

Carson City MSA seasonally adjusted total nonfarm employment realized a decrease of 300 jobs (-1.0%) from September 2020 to October 2020. Compared to October 2019 total nonfarm employment saw a decrease of 1,200 jobs (-3.9%). The leisure and hospitality sector added back 600 jobs (16.2%) over the year, while the manufacturing (0.0%) sector showed no change all compared to October 2019. Sector estimates are not adjusted for seasonality.




Local Area Unemployment Statistics ([LAUS](#))

Figures for our unemployment estimates come from the Local Area Unemployment Statistics (LAUS) program sponsored by the ([BLS-LAUS](#)). This program produces monthly and annual employment, unemployment, and labor force data for census regions, states, counties, metropolitan areas, and many large cities, based on place of residence.

The Las Vegas MSA's unemployment rate was 13.8 percent in October 2020, decreasing from 14.6 percent in September 2020, and up from 3.8 percent in October 2019, non-seasonally adjusted. The number of unemployed individuals decreased by 9,199 since September 2020 for a current level of 157,196 people, which is 114,268 more unemployed people than October 2019. The labor force in Las Vegas is currently 1,140,932 people, which is 1,375 less people than September 2020, and is up 1,963 people since October 2019.


The Reno MSA's unemployment rate was 6.3 percent in October 2020, decreasing from 6.7 percent in September 2020, and up from 2.8 percent in October 2019, non-seasonally adjusted. The number of unemployed individuals decreased by 965 since September 2020 for a current level of 16,113 people, which is 8,756 more unemployed people than October 2019. The labor force in Reno is currently 254,750 people, which is 837 less people than September 2020, and is down 6,428 people since October 2019.

The Carson City MSA's unemployment rate was 6.6 percent in October 2020, decreasing from 6.9 percent in September 2020, and up from 3.3 percent in October 2019, non-seasonally adjusted. The number of unemployed individuals decreased by 77 since September 2020 for a current level of 1,742 people, which is 868 more unemployed people than October 2019. The labor force in Carson City is currently 26,409 people, which is 84 less people than September 2020, and is up 0 people since October 2019.



Due to the magnitude of labor force changes during the COVID-19 pandemic, the BLS has temporarily modified the methodology used for sub-state estimation. These changes impact all small county (areas not part of an MSA) LAUS employment estimates, and tie their growth rate to the changes seen statewide (excluding Clark county). Unemployment estimates are unaffected by this change in methodology.

Unemployment Insurance Benefits (UI)

Regular initial claims for unemployment insurance totaled 37,891 statewide in October 2020, up over 10 percent from a month ago. At the sub-state level, these increases were seen across almost every county, with the average weekly initial claims filed up from September in all but four counties. In a typical year, these increases would be partially explained by expected seasonal movement, as October has historically been when Nevada sees a seasonal rise in initial claims. However, this year it is difficult to determine how much of the increase is seasonal and how much can be attributed to the pandemic. Continued claims, which are a proxy for the number of persons filing for regular UI benefits in each week, continue to see declines in the average number of claims filed. These declines are expected as many of the claimants that first filed in March and April have exhausted their benefits and moved into the extension programs.

As continued claim filings decline across all counties, the number of weeks compensated, and total benefits paid have correspondingly declined. Clark County saw \$105.0 million in benefit payments, down \$87.5 million from September. The rest of the state, including Washoe but not including the unknown county claims, saw \$13.9 million in regular benefits paid, a decline of \$7.4 from September's total of \$21.3 million. Final Payments, also known as benefit exhaustions, look to have peaked last month and have begun to decline across all counties.




Initial Claims by County
