**TOMORROW: Unemployment Insurance, DETR & JobConnect Sites  
Offline Temporarily for Regularly Scheduled Maintenance; No Impact to  
PUA Site**

CARSON CITY, NV - The Nevada Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation (DETR) has announced that in order to conduct regular system updates, they are temporarily taking the unemployment insurance system ([ui.nv.gov](http://ui.nv.gov)) and DETR and JobConnect sites offline tomorrow, Saturday, August 29, 2020. The unemployment insurance site will be offline tomorrow at 1 p.m. until 7 p.m., and the DETR & JobConnect sites ([detr.nv.gov](http://detr.nv.gov) and [nevadajobconnect.com](http://nevadajobconnect.com)) will be offline at 5 a.m. until 7 a.m.

During these times, the sites get very few visitors, making it the optimal time to make regular updates. During this brief window, individuals will not be able to file claims or access the resource materials. Filers are encouraged to visit the sites after 7 p.m. tomorrow night and 7 a.m. tomorrow respectively. This maintenance will not impact the PUA site ([employnv.gov](http://employnv.gov)) and individuals filing PUA claims online will not be affected.
