

2020:IQ Nevada Unemployment Rate Demographics Report*

Department of Employment, Training &

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Executive Summary

The Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 232.920 requires a quarterly report by the Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation which disaggregates the rate of unemployment by demographic groups for each county within the State utilizing currently available information, and to post this report on their website. This report is also available on the website for the Research and Analysis Bureau within the Department. Additionally, this report is provided to the Governor's Workforce Development Board, as well as other applicable agencies providing workforce development services.

NRS 232.935 mandates the Governor's Workforce Investment Board require all applicable agencies which provide workforce services to coordinate efforts and resources in order to reduce the rate of unemployment for specific demographic groups when certain thresholds are met:

1. When the unemployment rate is at least double (200 percent) the rate of unemployment for the county as a whole.
2. When the unemployment rate is at least four percentage points higher than the rate of unemployment for the county as a whole.
3. When the unemployment rate has been higher than the rate of unemployment for the county as a whole for at least three consecutive years.

Pursuant to these requirements, available information from the U.S. Census Bureau's American Community Survey highlights particular groups around the state who are most likely to face higher unemployment rates than the region as a whole.

For the State's three most populous areas, the summary of the available information¹ for 2018 is as follows:

Clark County

Based on the five-year ACS figures from 2014-2018, the following seven demographic groups had a high unemployment rate in ten or more counties of the Silver State:

- People ages 16 to 19 had a high unemployment rate in 14 counties. This is up from 13 counties in 2013-2017 period.
- People living below poverty level in 14 counties. This is unchanged from 2013-2017 period.
- American Indian or Alaska Native in 13 counties. This is unchanged from 2013-2017 period. People ages 20 to 24 years in 11 counties. This is down from 12 counties in 2013-2017 period.
- People with less than High School education in 10 counties. This is down from 11 counties in 2013-2017 period.
- People with High School or equivalent education in 10 counties. This is unchanged from 2013-2017 period.
- People with disabilities in 10 counties. This is unchanged from 2013-2017 period.

The U.S. Census Bureau's American Community Survey (ACS) also provides one-year estimates for areas with population of 65,000 and over. Although the sample size is smaller than the 5-year estimates, the data is more current.

Utilizing the 2018 one-year ACS estimates we can evaluate which demographic groups have a high unemployment in Clark County and in Washoe County. The estimates show that:

- In Clark County, 12 demographic groups have a high unemployment rate. This is up from 11 groups in 2017. People ages 75 and older and Female with children 0-5 years old have a high unemployment rate over the year in 2018. Females no longer have a high unemployment rate over the year in 2018.

- In Washoe County, 9 demographics groups have a high unemployment rate. This is unchanged from 2017. However, this is because two groups were added, and two groups were removed. American Indian & Alaska Natives and Females with children 0-5 years old have high unemployment over the year in 2018. While people 20-24 years old and Females with 0-5 and 6-17 no longer have a high unemployment rate over the year in 2018.

County Information & Data Sources

For purposes of satisfying the specific requirements of NRS 232.920, this Report utilizes the U.S. Census Bureau's American Community Survey (ACS) to generate demographic profiles of the unemployed by county. The ACS is a nationwide survey that provides information every year on the demographic, social, economic, and housing characteristics of the nation's population.

- The Survey produces single-year and multiyear estimates. The one-year estimates provide information for geographic areas, including counties, with populations greater than 65,000. In Nevada, 15 of 17 counties do not meet that threshold. Although the sample size is smaller than the five-year estimates, the data is more current.
- ACS multiyear estimates produce results covering a five-year period. These estimates are relatively reliable, especially for Nevada's smaller counties.

Unfortunately, in the process of generating reliable and comparable information for all counties in Nevada, timeliness becomes an issue. The most recent information covers the 2014-2018 period. In Nevada as a whole, 18,000 households (out of a total of 2.1 million) were interviewed as part of the ACS in 2018.

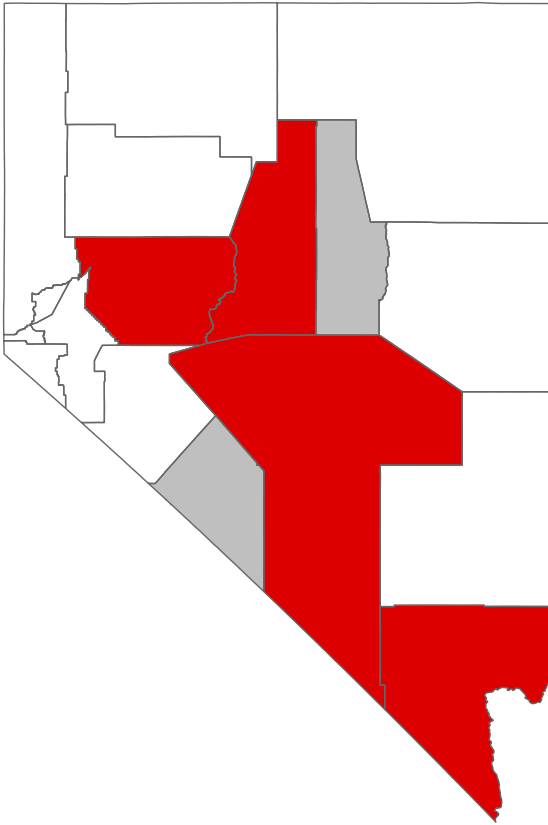


Sex, 20–64: Female, With Children 0–17

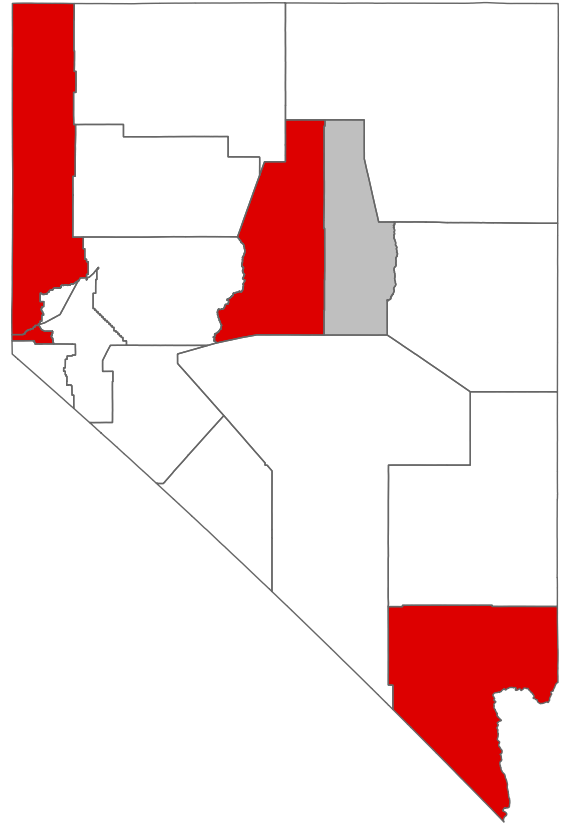

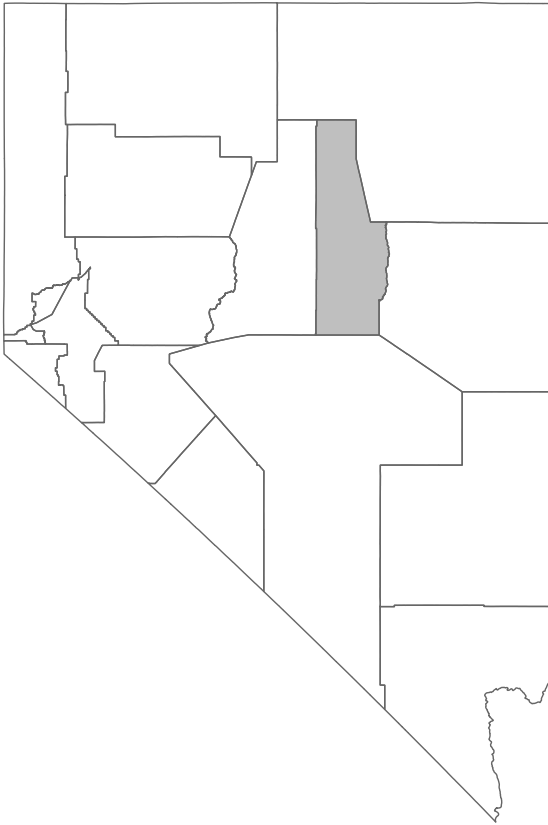


Poverty Status, Age 20–64: Below Poverty Level

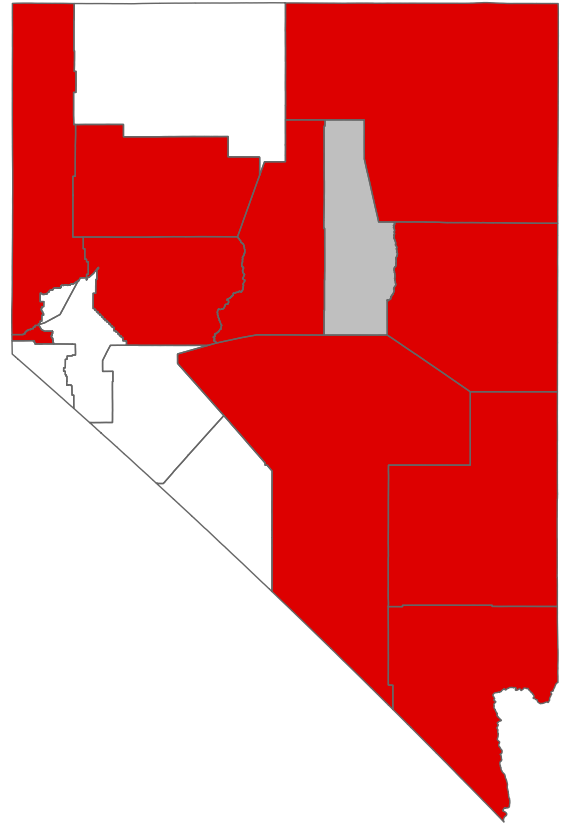

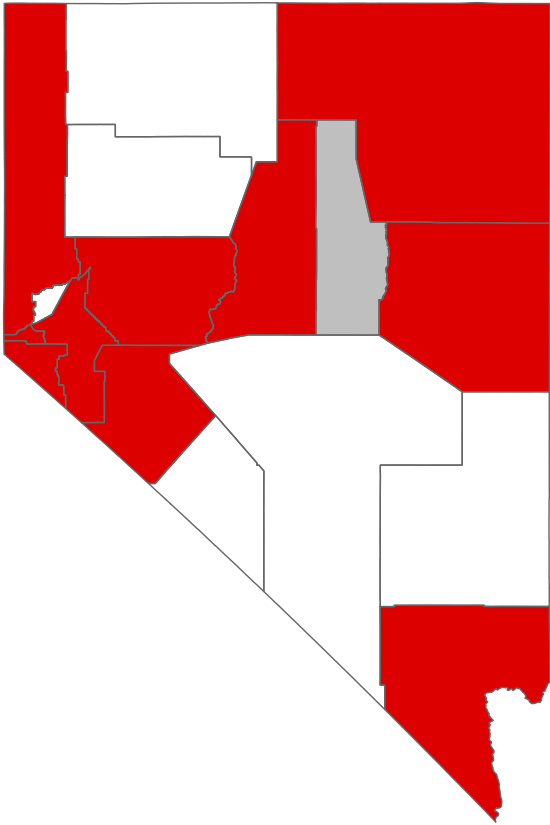


Education, Age 25–64: Less Than High School

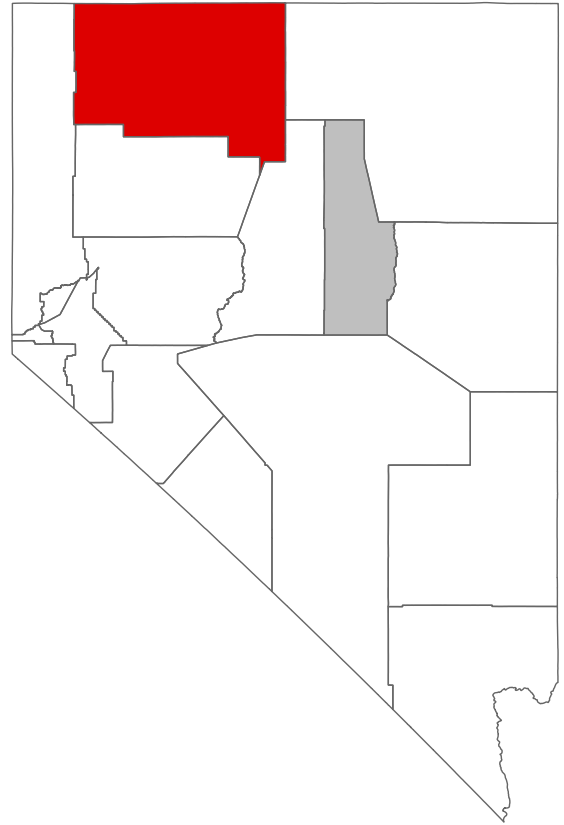

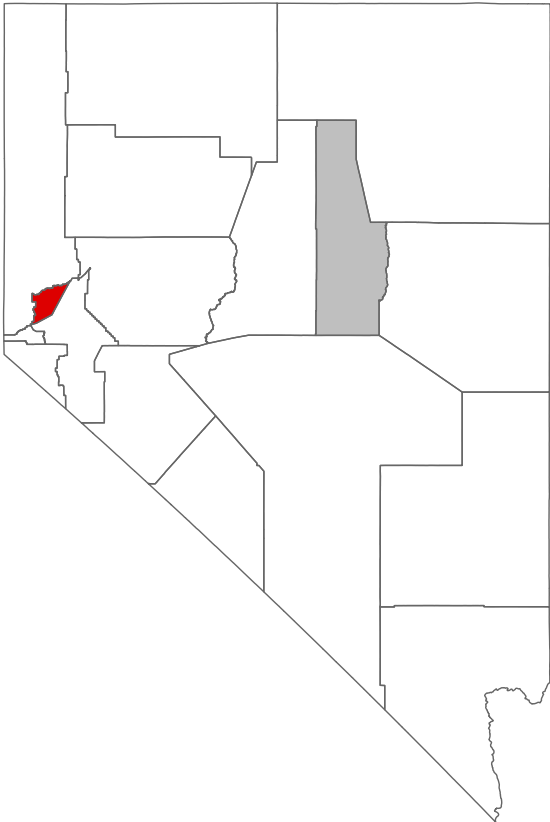
Education, Age 25–64: High School

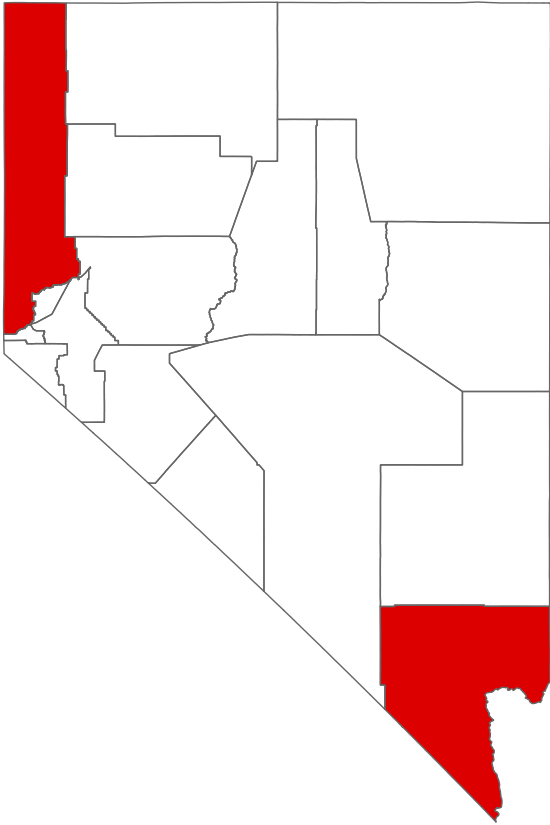


Sex, 20–64: Female, With Children 0–17

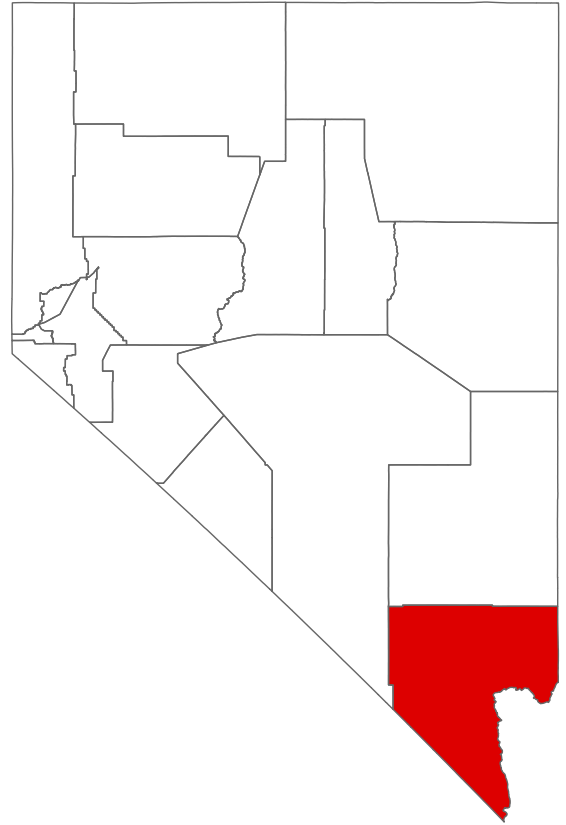

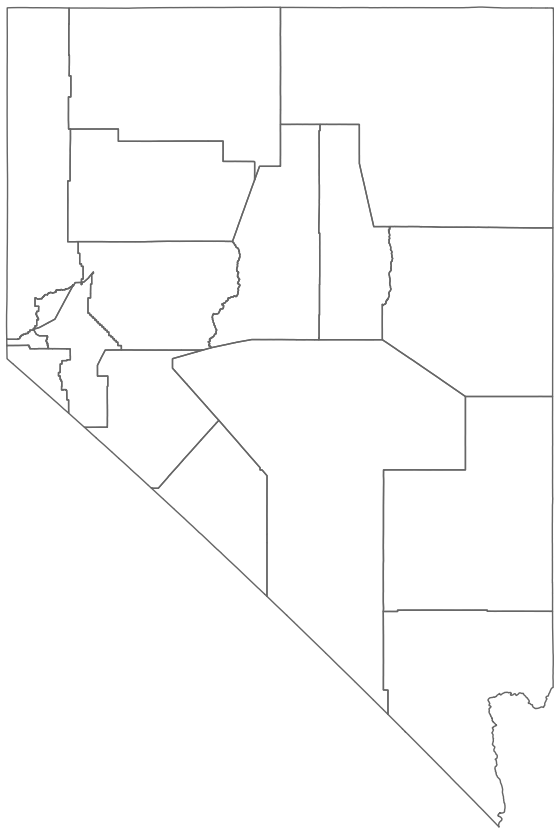


Poverty Status, Age 20–64: Below Poverty Level

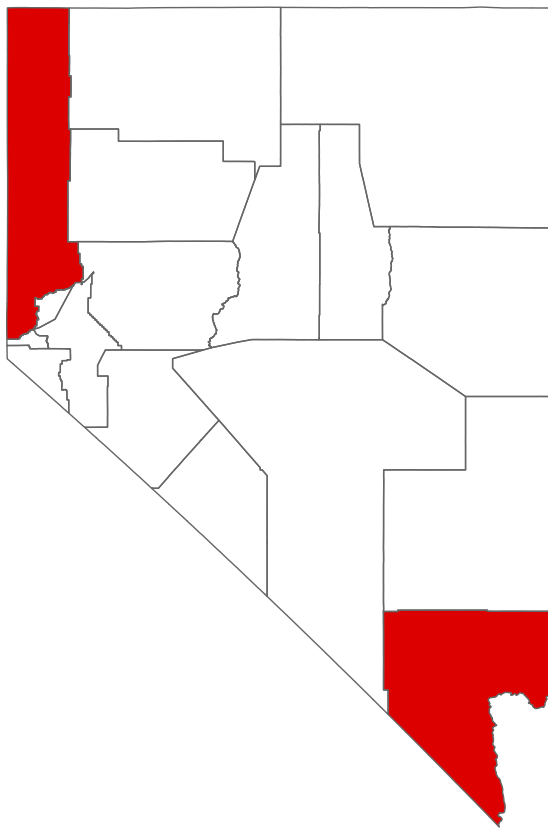

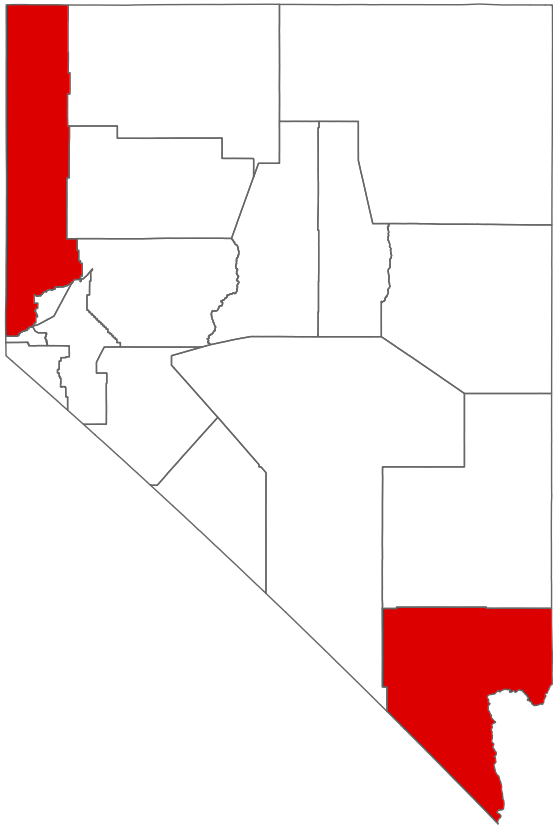


Education, Age 25–64: Less Than High School

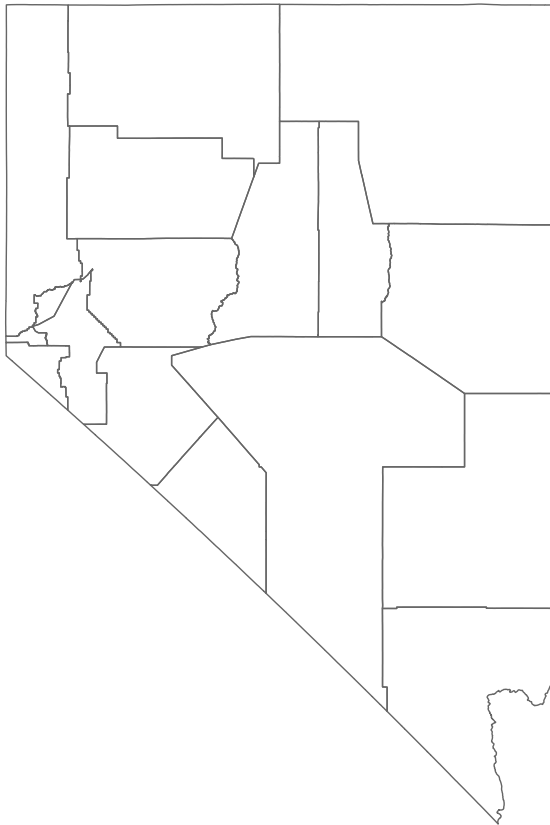
